A Message from Chandrika Tandon

It is a deep honor for me to perform at this benefit concert for AHINSA. For many years, I have admired all of the work that sOm Sharma and AHINSA have done and continue to do for the advancement of peace, spirituality, and human enlightenment—all causes very dear to my heart.

This concert comes at an especially poignant time as I share songs from my brand new album, *Soul Ecstasy*, which is a series of compositions based on traditional classical Indian ragas with multiple rhythm patterns using Sanskrit words and texts, which was released just a week ago. My long-term collaborator, the sarod maestro Tejendra Narayan Majumdar brought together approximately 75 classically trained artists including Indian singers and additional maestros of percussion, flute, sarangi, shehnai, sitar, tabla, pakhavaj, and veena. In tonight's concert, we will excerpt some songs from this new album with a wonderful live band of musicians from my ensemble and the incredible MCG, and including every member of the audience who wishes to join in.

Every tradition of classical Indian music invites us to get in touch with our own divinity. Music has been the biggest instrument in my journey to finding my stillness and dedicating myself to a life of service. The albums I have released over the past decade are built upon this, and *Soul Ecstasy* takes it one step further by nourishing the radiance in our hearts to become ecstatic. I hope all of us can find the radiance within and help make the planet a better place.






